Program History



- Every student enrolled in a BC secondary school must complete the “Graduation Transitions Standards.”
- The program begins in grade 10, continues in grade 11 and is completed in grade 12.
- Successful completion of the program will earn 4 credits towards the Dogwood Diploma.
- This is required for graduation status.

Three Categories for Completion



- ❖ Personal Health
- ❖ Career and Life Planning
- ❖ Community Connections

Personal Health



1. Healthy Living Plan requirement

- Complete either Plan A OR Plan B depending on whether or not you have your PE 10 Active Health Project
- This **TERM ONE** requirement is due September 18th, 2017.

2. Daily Physical Activity requirements

- Enrolled in, and passing, PE 11/12, Weight Training, or Dance? You automatically receive credit.
- If not enrolled in the above, track your progress either online or on a paper calendar **from September to May.**

Career and Life Planning



1. Career and Life Plan requirement

- Complete either Plan A OR Plan B depending on whether or not you have your Planning 10 Project (Career & Post-Secondary Research Project)
- Both Plan A and Plan B require an updated resume
- This **TERM ONE** requirement is due October 24th, 2017.

Community Connections



1. 30 hours of Work Experience or Volunteer Work requirement

To complete this, you may...

- take WEX12A (90 hours of Work Experience) as a course,
- complete 30 hours Work Experience (set up by Ms. Jackson) OR 30 hours paid work or volunteer work and complete the applicable paperwork.
- Completed forms are due by the end Friday, April 6th, 2018 – right after **SPRING BREAK**.

Exit Interview Requirement



1. The student-led Exit Interview will occur on
Thursday, April 19th, 2018

- use your completed Graduation Transitions Portfolio of work as an interview starting point - **it needs to be complete!!!
- bring 2 or 3 pieces of evidence to show some of your accomplishments from the past few years
- present yourself, and your achievements, to a community member
- celebrate your success, look ahead to your future
